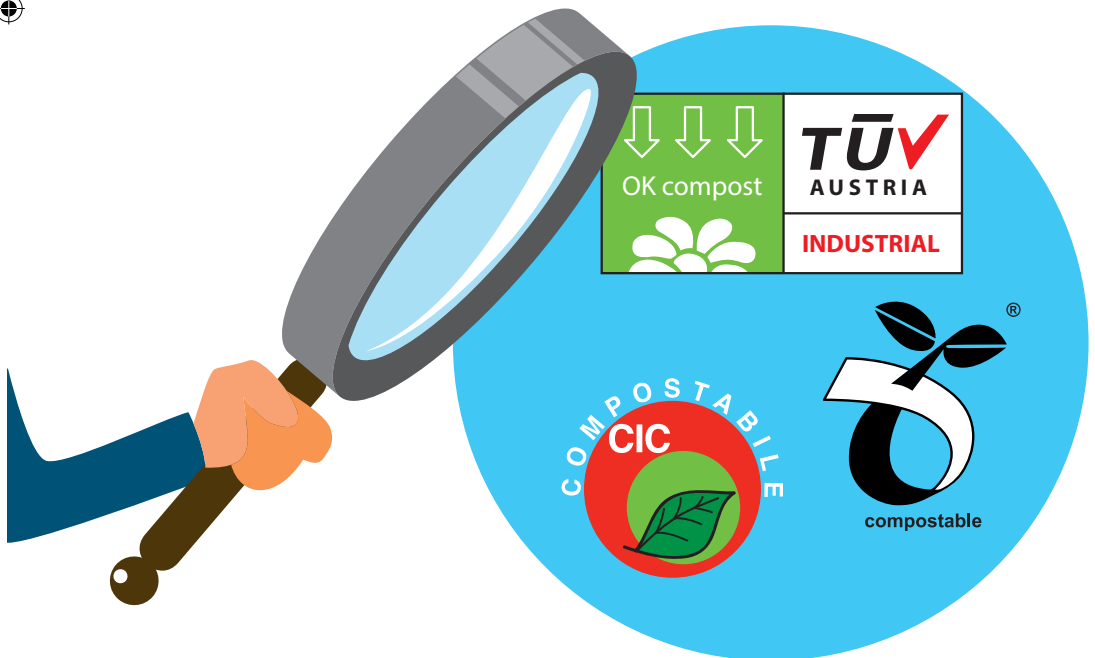
Some products, made with **POLYMERS OF VEGETABLE ORIGIN**, can be **disposed of together with food waste** to be transformed into **compost**.

WHICH ONES?

- **Bioplastics:** made with renewable raw materials, they are biodegradable and compostable. They can be turned into compost if collected together with your food scraps.
- **Kitchen paper:** if soiled with food it can be discarded in the organics bin.*
- **Paper and cardboard combined with compostable bioplastic.**

HOW TO RECOGNIZE THEM?

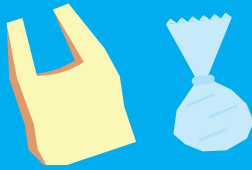
They must always be **certified according to the European standard EN13432** and must include at least one of the following logos along with the word "**compostable**":



*PLEASE NOTE:

Clean paper and cardboard packaging must be thrown into the paper bin.

Here you find examples of these new products that can be put in the organics bin. To be sure, look for at least one of the logos and the word "compostable".



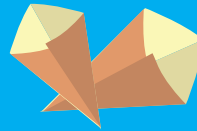
Compostable waste bags, shopping bags, fresh product bags, freezer bags



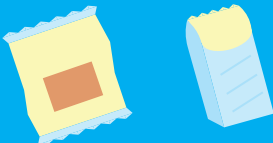
Compostable tableware like cups, dishes, bowls, cutlery, lids, straws, stirrers



Compostable bags for bread and sandwiches in bioplastic or paper and bioplastic



Compostable coated paper used to wrap food



Compostable bioplastic bags for salads, cereals, legumes, dry pasta, fridge or frozen products



Rigid containers, trays and packaging made of transparent bioplastic or coated cardboard, certified compostable



Compostable coffee capsules, pods and filters



REMEMBER

For the collection of organic waste, only use certified bioplastic or paper bags in compliance with the UNI EN 13432-2002 standard. They can be purchased from shops, supermarkets and other sales networks.
